

MAS Membership Benefits



1. Institutional Voting: meets MAS' bylaw definition of a museum and are located in Saskatchewan. Fees are based on annual operating expenditure.
\$0 - \$10,000 - \$50; \$10,001 - \$100,000 - \$80; \$100,001 - \$500,000 - \$175; \$500,001 - \$1,000,000 - \$275; \$1,000,001+ - \$425.
2. Institutional Non-Voting: working toward but ineligible for institutional voting membership and are located in Saskatchewan.
3. Associate: any organization ineligible for institutional membership.
4. Individual Voting: are residents of Saskatchewan who support MAS goals and objectives.
5. Individual Non-Voting: are Saskatchewan residents who choose to have non-voting status, or are non-residents of Saskatchewan.
6. Individual Student: attends an accredited program full-time. Proof of registration is required at time of application.
